WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

CONNECT HIGH

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COMMON LANGUAGE ABOUT INSTRUCTION

“REMOTE”

The instructor and the students are not in the same physical space. Instruction may occur asynchronously or synchronously.

“HYBRID”

A combination of on-campus and remote learning. Students are expected to be physically present together in class for some portion of the instruction.

COMMON LANGUAGE ABOUT INSTRUCTION

“REMOTE”

The instructor and the students are not in the same physical space. Instruction may occur asynchronously or synchronously.

DV REMOTE

DVR Students participate together in classes taught by teachers from all three schools via remote instruction. Students are enrolled in the schools on “independent study” contracts.

“HYBRID”

A combination of on-campus and remote learning. Students are expected to be physically present together in class 2 days per week.

DV CONNECT

DV’s rigorous, hybrid, early college program in which students earn an AA or BA through SNHU or 60 units of transferable credits for free, all while earning their high school diploma.

DV REMOTE (DVR) PROGRAM COMPONENTS

CORE COURSES

DVR students complete the courses required for a DV High School diploma and are eligible for UC/CSU upon graduation. Courses are taught as extra sections by DV teachers.

FLEXIBILITY

DVR students have the option of taking math courses at an accelerated sequence and have multiple options for foreign language through Rosetta Stone.



ADVISORY

DVR students join an advisory family that meets regularly for socioemotional learning, college counseling, & personal connections.

ATHLETICS & ACTIVITIES

DVR students are encouraged to participate with their on-campus program peers in school athletics & activities.

EARLY COLLEGE

DV Connect students begin their college journey in 9th grade with Southern New Hampshire University, El Camino College and UCLA Extension, at no cost to families!

REAL WORLD LEARNING

Students learn best when their work reflects the world around them. We contextualize student learning through workforce competencies, inquiry based learning, financial literacy and industry partnerships.



HYBRID LEARNING

We believe in the best of both worlds! Students benefit from an on-campus community of peers and staff 2 days per week and remote learning 3 days per week.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

EARLY COLLEGE @ CONNECT HIGH?

- 70% of US high school grads go to college. Only 60% earn a Bachelor's degree after 6 years of college. We can change that!
- College classes begin in 9th grade
- 3 x 3 schedule
 - 3 year-long classes per semester = 6 classes per year
 - Fewer classes at a time but still take HS A-G + college courses
- Dual enrollment
 - College classes count for HS *and* college units
 - Honors credit/GPA boost for college classes

Transferring Between Da Vinci Schools

Da Vinci Remote students may request to transfer to an on-campus school via an Intra-School Transfer Request. Transfers are possible only during the summer. Transfers are approved based on space availability, the student's good standing and administration approval, and are not guaranteed.

DA VINCI CONNECT HS

Transferring Between Da Vinci Schools

Da Vinci Connect high school students may not transfer to Da Vinci Communications, Da Vinci Design or Da Vinci Science unless the student attended Da Vinci Connect TK-8 and/or has an enrollment priority.

ENROLLMENT NEXT STEPS

1. **Login to SchoolMint at <https://davincischools.schoolmint.net> to:**
 - a. Complete the Intent to Return (returning students)
 - b. Add/Apply to Connect High and/or DV Remote (all students)
2. **Apply by the Priority Application Deadline - June 21, 2020**
3. As you re-enroll/apply keep in mind **what do you want for your child(ren) for the long-term**
4. We will begin offering spots at Connect High and Da Vinci Remote starting the week of June 22 in the order of enrollment preferences
5. If you accept a spot at Connect High or Da Vinci Remote, you will no longer be enrolled or on the waitlist for the on-campus programs
