



Hybrid

DV Connect (TK-8)

A hybrid model combining homeschool and on-campus instruction using project-based and social-emotional learning.

DV RISE High (9-12)

A holistic model with wraparound supports to meet the unique needs of homeless, foster, and other youth who have experienced disruptions in their academic journeys.

DV Connect (9-12)

An early college program in which students can earn a two-or four-year college degree while in high school.

DV Extension (College)

A dual enrollment program in which 12th grade DV students may stay at DV to earn an AA, BA or one year of GE college credits for FREE.

A fully remote and flexible version of the Da Vinci Schools model that prepares students for success in college and the workplace.
