


PARAMETERS OF OUR PHASE II PLAN

- ALL planning done with equity in mind
- 29 days left in the year, this includes state testing, Celebrations of Learning, MAP testing, and graduation
- Maintain integrity of current virtual academic instructional program--students stay with teachers/classmates

- Number of student invitations based on staff availability
- Room capacity is 14 students and 1 adult per classroom
- Outside space available including tented areas--tent capacity is 12 students to 1 teacher

- 6ft of physical distancing
- Students in "stable" groups
- Teachers supervise limited number of "stable" groups
- Additional protocols as outlined in our <u>COVID</u> <u>handbook</u>







CONTINUING VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION FOR ALL STUDENTS

- Virtual academic instruction will continue from 9:00 am-11:45 am for all students
- Students will be on Zoom with the same teacher and classmates (no shuffling)






ON CAMPUS INSTRUCTION FOR SOME STUDENTS



- Students indicated as <u>highest priority</u> will be invited to log in to Zoom classes from campus on "at school" days, from 9:00am-11:45am
- Approx. 40 students per cohort
- For special education students, a separate e-mail/survey will go out to discuss in-person SAI services





- Bring Da Vinci Chromebook and headset from home
- Enter and exit at front gate
- Must bring re-usable water bottle
- May bring a snack
- If staying for afternoon activities, must also bring lunch/sign up for Grab n Go from Meal Services
- Must follow all COVID protocols

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES FOR <u>ALL</u> STUDENTS



- 1:00-3:00pm on regular cohort day(s)
- Enter and exit at back field
- 100% outdoors to maximize safety and capacity
- Schedule based on Student interest and staff availability--Up to 150 students per day
- Must bring reusable water bottle and MAY bring a snack
- Must bring a towel / yoga mat for sitting
- Must follow all COVID protocols

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES FOR ALL STUDENTS



- Adherence to "stable" groupings for students
- Groupings will focus on exposure to classmates to build connection (sibling schedules may not match)
- Emphasis on building community, social emotional connections, and play
- Students who choose not to participate will continue to have virtual social hour opportunities


Data collected following Family Town Hall on 3/1

- 525/883 (59%) Da Vinci families (from ALL campuses) "Prefer some in person activities with remote instruction"






- Academic Support and Social Emotional Support are highest priorities
- Most frequently checked statement on "click all that apply" is All educational staff have access to vaccines




STUDENT DATA

Data collected following Family Town Hall through a survey in grades 4-8 and in a modified survey for grades TK-3



How concerned are you about COVID transmission happening at school / on campus?



In Grades 4-8:

- "I feel most ready to go back to school when..." (Click all that apply)
- Out of 175 responses, 73 responses included (at least) "all educational staff have access to vaccines"
- 74 responses included "I am ready now"
- 42 responses included "I don't know when I will feel comfortable"

In TK-3:

- 54 students want to come back
- 25 want to stay home
- 12 either didn't know or had other answers
