

Honors

Honors courses at Da Vinci...

- Are NOT separate classes; students can earn honors in their "regular" classes.
- Can be earned by any student at Da Vinci.
- Require additional and/or deeper work like an additional project, extra assignments, etc.
- Must demonstrate a high level of content mastery.
- Are typically rolled out by teachers in their classes in September.





Taking honors courses and earning high grades is the best way to:

- Show colleges that you're taking the most rigorous courses offered by your school.
- Raise your GPA! When you get an honors designation on your transcript, you also get a one-point GPA boost.







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Enrollment Process

- ✓ Submit a New Student Application by February 29, 2024 @ 11:59 pm
 All families, including Wiseburn residents, must apply so we know you are interested
- ✓ Wiseburn Residents are offered a spot prior to the lottery
- ✓ Attend the high school lottery on March 7, 2024 @ 6:00 pm (optional)
- ✓ Enrollment offers are sent via email/text, wait-list results available in SchoolMint on or about March 15, 2024
- \checkmark If offered a spot, registration documents are submitted electronically
- ✓ Enrollment support for newly admitted high school families: (by appointment)
- √ If you fail to complete registration by the deadline, you will lose your space, open spaces will be given to students on the waitlist
- √ School begins in mid-August 2024 Students who miss the first day of school may lose their space

Intra-School Transfer Requests

- We have a very limited number of openings for current students seeking to transfer from one Da Vinci school to another for the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.
- Before accepting an offer of enrollment, families should understand that the school they are enrolling in is for the long-term.
- We do have a process to request an Intra-School Transfer. The priority window to request an intra-school transfer is January 2 - February 29, 2024. The form will be available on our website under Transfer Requests. Completion of the form is not a guarantee of transfer.
- Intra-School Transfers are made based on reason for the request, space availability, the student's good standing, and administrator approval.
- Transfer request final decisions take place the first week in June.

New Transfer Students

We have a limited number of openings for new students seeking to transfer in the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

- ✓ After an offer of conditional enrollment, applicants must submit transcripts from all prior high schools the student has attended before a final offer is made.
- ✓ Transcripts are used for grade level determination, not for admissions purposes.
- ✓ Transfer applicants who turn in a timely application are entered into the lottery in order to determine waitlist ranking. Late applications are put at the bottom of the waiting list.
- ✓ Transfer students usually receive notifications during the summer.
