



Dual Enrollment at CHS



DV Connect Enrollment Priorities

- 1. Wiseburn Residents
- 2. Siblings of currently enrolled Da Vinci Connect students in grades TK-11
- Children of Da Vinci and Wiseburn teachers, staff and Board members
- Students who are currently attending Wiseburn
 K-8 schools on permit (entered District in K-5)
- Students who are currently attending Wiseburn K-8 schools on permit (entered District in 6th grade)
- 6. All Others



Enrollment Process

- ✓ Submit a New Student Application by February 28, 2026 @ 11:59 pm
 All families, including Wiseburn residents, must apply so we know you are interested
- ✓ Wiseburn Residents are offered a spot prior to the lottery
- ✓ Attend the high school lottery on March 6, 2026 @ 5:30 pm (in-person attendance optional)
- ✓ Enrollment offers are sent via email/text, wait-list results available in SchoolMint on or about March 17, 2026
- ✓ If offered a spot, registration documents are submitted electronically
- ✓ If you fail to complete registration by the deadline, you will lose your space, open spaces will be given to students on the waitlist
- ✓ School begins in mid-August 2026 Students who miss the first day of school may lose their space if they have not communicated with the front office/ enrollment team.

Intra-School Transfer Requests

- We have a very limited number of openings for current students seeking to transfer from one Da Vinci school to another for the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.
- Before accepting an offer of enrollment, families should understand that the school they are enrolling in is for the **long-term**.
- ❖ We do have a process to request an Intra-School Transfer. The priority window to request an intra-school transfer is **January 1-February 28**. A form will be available on the DV website on or about Jan. 1. Completion of the form is not a guarantee of transfer.
- Intra-School Transfers are made based on space availability, the student's good standing, and administrator approval.
- Transfer request final decisions take place during the summer for the upcoming school year.

New Transfer Students to Da Vinci

We have a limited number of openings for new students seeking to transfer in the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

- ✓ After an offer of conditional enrollment, applicants must submit transcripts from all prior high schools the student has attended before a final offer is made.
- ✓ Transcripts are used for grade level determination, not for admissions purposes.
- ✓ Transfer applicants who turn in a timely application are entered into the lottery in order to determine waitlist ranking. Late applications are put at the bottom of the waiting list.
- ✓ Transfer students usually receive notifications during the summer.
