Why Project-Based Learning?

Content Mastery. Meaningful Work. Personal Connection.

- **Learning by Doing.** Students work in teams to solve real-world problems and demonstrate mastery of key skills (collaboration, critical thinking, communication, creativity, etc.)
- **Engaged Hearts and Minds.** Students actively engage in projects with real-world relevance and solve problems that are important to them and their communities.
- **Deeper Learning.** PBL leads to deeper learning and greater retention of content knowledge.
- **Adults and Careers.** Students interact with adults and businesses in the community and begin to develop career interests.

A-G Curriculum & Why It Matters

- In 2024, only 44% of California high school seniors completed the minimum A-G coursework required to be eligible to apply to the state's UC and Cal State universities.
- **94% of DV graduates meet the UC/Cal State A-G course requirements in 2024.**
- At Da Vinci, you can't take a "wrong" class. By design, all of our classes meet the A-G course requirements and count toward California's UC/Cal State eligibility requirements with a letter grade of C or better.



CTE Completion & Why It Matters

- In 2024, only 20% of California high school seniors completed an approved Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway.
- **69% of DVC, DVD, & DVS graduates completed at least one CTE pathway in 2024.** CTE programs at Connect and RISE are in early implementation.
- **68% of Da Vinci graduates leave with both college preparation and hands-on, career-connected learning experiences that set them apart in college, internships, and the workforce.**

Admissions officers are also looking not just for *any* extracurricular activities, they want to know if students are doing things they’re passionate about, and doing extracurricular things that align with the majors they’re applying for.”

- Fewer subjects accepted, higher score requirements, caps on total credits



We Emphasize Dual Enrollment (college courses)



- Earned through deeper or extended work (projects, mastery tasks)



Off to the next adventure!

- 92% of all Da Vinci graduates completed the A-G college entrance requirements, a rate almost 50% higher than the 2024 State Average.
- 79% of all Da Vinci graduates enrolled in college immediately after high school, 15% higher than most recent State and National Averages.
- 89% of Da Vinci graduates persist in second year of college, 13% higher than the National Average.
- Da Vinci students are being accepted to a wide range of elite colleges and universities across the country.

4. Students on permit who entered the Wiseburn Unified School District or DV Connect charter in 6th grade
5. Students who entered the DV Connect charter in 7th or 8th grades
6. Siblings of students currently enrolled in a Da Vinci School from grades 9-11 of the previous school year
7. All Others



DV Connect Enrollment Priorities

Intra-School Transfer Requests

- ❖ We have a **very limited** number of openings for current students seeking to transfer from one Da Vinci school to another for the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.
- ❖ Before accepting an offer of enrollment, families should understand that the school they are enrolling in is for the **long-term**.
- ❖ We do have a process to request an Intra-School Transfer. The priority window to request an intra-school transfer is **January 2 - February 28, 2026** for the following school year. The form will be available on our website under Transfer Requests. Completion of the form is not a guarantee of transfer.
- ❖ Intra-School Transfers are made based on reason for the request, the student's good standing, administrator approval, and space availability.
- ❖ Transfer request final decisions take place in April.

New Transfer Students

We have a limited number of openings for new students seeking to transfer in the 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

- ✓ Transfer applicants who turn in a timely application are entered into the lottery in order to determine waitlist ranking. Late applications are put at the bottom of the waiting list.
- ✓ Transfer students usually receive notifications late spring/early summer.
- ✓ After an offer of conditional enrollment, applicants must submit transcripts from all prior high schools the student has attended before a final offer is made.
- ✓ Transcripts are used for grade level determination, not for admissions purposes.
